

Discipleship Commission Report - June 4,2022

Following the PCCNA February meeting where the Commission highlighted their involvement with the He Gets Us national media campaign, more than a dozen briefings have been conducted for approx 100 Overseers, District Superintendents & Regional Bishops. Each briefing highlights the Discipleship Commission's Pray-Care-Share digital resources which are made available without cost in support of the He Gets Us evangelism outreach. A six-session sermon series incorporating the Spirit-empowered Discipleship Outcomes is being developed to support churches in this outreach for Fall 2022.

The Spring session of 13 different On-line training courses in Whole-Life Discipleship was conducted and the summer series scheduled to begin in July ; the Commission continues in partnership with Barna Research to develop this important " broadening" of the John 10:10 abundant life promise to include a Discipleship emphasis not only in our faith but also our relationships, wellness , vocation & stewardship. these 6 session facilitated courses have been made available without cost to more than 1400 pastors & church leaders over the past two years.

In support of various PCCNA members, special training workshops for the National Hispanic Leadership Conference and for America Prays National leadership were hosted in Austin,Texas and for the African Strategic Prayer Leaders gathering in Jacksonville Fla. Grant writing support to Sammy Rodriguez, Tony Suarez and the NHCLC was provided in May toward a Lilly Foundation Grant in "Compelling Preaching" which includes a focus on Whole-Life Discipleship. Plans are underway to support the Church of God of Prophecy General Assembly this summer with a booth and briefing emphasis on the He Gets Us evangelism outreach.
