**Introductions and Prayer:** Chair Kay Horner welcomed everyone and invited participants to share brief personal introductions. She introduced Keziah Obi to share a devotional thought and prayer.

**Uniting in Prayer and the Word:** Keziah shared inspirational insights from chapters two and four of Acts. She emphasized the importance of being in one mind and one accord. Paul and Silas' unity in prayer shook their prison cell. Relating personal prayer experiences, Keziah spoke of rest being a place to depend on God. We need to be at rest and in quietness. True biblical rest involves ceasing from our labor.

**Minutes:** Secretary Stephanie Truelove presented the March 2021 meeting minutes for review. Cheryl Koop made the motion that the minutes be accepted as presented and Susan Wells seconded. None were opposed, and the minutes were accepted as presented.

- ☞ Share a goal or passion you sense Holy Spirit has placed in your heart to pursue during 2022.


